WEEKENDS, SPECIAL EVENTS, TECH **SUPPORT & CAMPUS MINISTRIES**

Our Worship Gatherings provide an opportunity for God's people to gather and praise, pray, give and study God's Word together, including those who participate online. Special Events consist of discipleship, times of fellowship, training, and equipping. Technical Support provides the behind-the-scenes ministry for audio, visual, video, and staging for our ministries, including our online ministry. Campus Ministries is support of ministry events at our Modesto and Ceres Campuses.

Budget includes music and worship, special days and events, stage lighting and set design, audio production, video production, online ministries, and Modesto and Ceres Campus ministry events.

FAMILY & STUDENT MINISTRIES

Big Valley Grace is committed to making disciples among our children (birth-elementary) and youth (junior high-high school). We provide relevant, age-appropriate teaching through Bible lessons, worship, and small group activities. Young people hear the Good News, with opportunities to trust and grow in their relationships with Jesus.

Budget includes ministry to infants, early childhood, elementary, middle school and high school students.

ADULT MINISTRIES

Adult Ministries equip the people of Big Valley Grace and our greater community by providing ministry relevant to every stage and season of life. Men, Women, and Marriage Ministries help people deepen their relationships with Jesus and share their faith with others.

Budget includes Men, Women, adult classes, life groups, Marriage Ministries and the Branch Library

SERVE, CONNECT & CARE MINISTRIES



Recovery Ministries support, encourage and provide biblical resources to overcome hurts, habits, and hang-ups, helping people to experience freedom and victory in Jesus.


Budget includes Celebrate Recovery, The Landing, Rock Solid Kids, premarital mentoring and lay counseling.

Administrative Support provides administrative, clerical, and organizational services to facilitate the operation of all programs of ministry.

Budget includes the business office, accounting, information technology services and food services.
